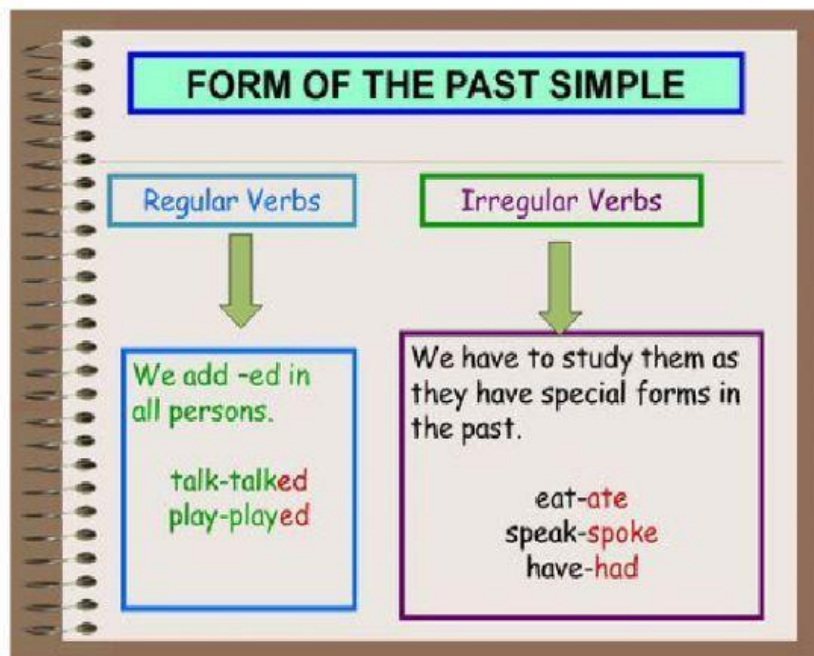

AFF +

I jumped...
You ate...
He cooked...

NEG-

I **didn't** jump...
You **didn't** eat...
He **didn't** cook...
She **didn't** write...
It **didn't** run...
We **didn't** shout...
You **didn't** read...
They **didn't** open...

INT?

Did I jump...?
Did you eat...?
Did he cook...?
Did she write...?
Did it run...?
Did we shout...?
Did you read...?
Did they open...?

REGULAR VERBS: just add +ed in the AFF+, **didn't** NEG- and Did+pers.pronoun (he, they, you...)? in the INT ?
IRREGULAR VERBS: in the AFF+ different form (write-wrote)
NEG – didn't, Did + personal pronoun (he, she, we...) in the INT ?

Past Simple: Irregular Verbs

- Many Past Simple verbs are irregular. Study the grammar reference chart below.

Below are 64 commonly used **Past Simple** irregular verbs in English.

For example:

"My friend **buys** a newspaper every day."

"My friend **bought** a newspaper yesterday."
