B.- Adjectives ending in "E"drop the "E" and add "er" and "the est"

_____	large	larger	the largest

C.- Adjectives with one syllable

ending in 1 vowel and 1 consonant double the consonant and add "er" and "the est"

_____	big	bigger	the biggest
_____	hot	hotter	the hottest
_____	wet	wetter	the wettest

D.- Adjectives with two syllables ending in "y"drop the "y" change into "i"

and add "er" and "the est"

_____	happy	happier	the happiest
_____	easy	easier	the easiest
_____	funny	funnier	the funniest
