

The nervous system

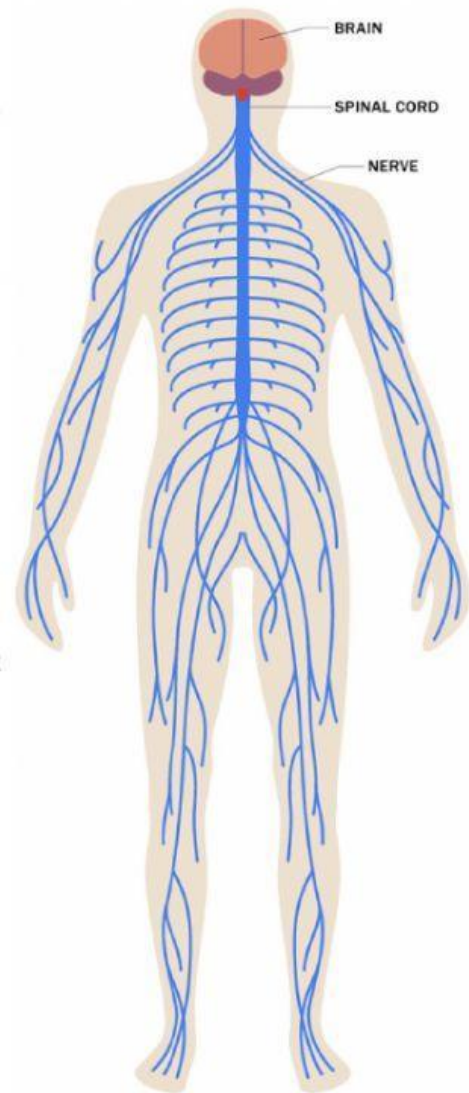
The nervous system controls everything you do: Thinking, walking, talking, etc. The nervous system is made up of the brain, spinal cord and nerves.

Brain and nerves

The most important part of the nervous system is the brain. This organ is inside your head and is protected by the skull.

The brain receives different types of information from the sense organs (ears, tongue, skin, eyes and nose) through the nerves.

The brain reads the signals sent by the sense organs. Then it sends messages back to different parts of the body.
