DIRECT QUESTIONS	REPORTED QUESTIONS
Present Simple Does she always wear a coat? →	Past Simple He wanted to know if she always wore a coat.
Present Continuous Are you looking for your keys? →	Past Continuous He wanted to know if I was looking for my keys.
Present Perfect Has she submitted the answers yet? →	Past Perfect He asked if she had submitted the answers yet.
Past Simple Did you do your homework? →	Past Perfect He asked if I had done my homework.
Will Will you finish the report in two days? →	Would He wanted to know if I would finish the report in two days.
Be going to Are you going to travel this summer? →	Future in the Past (was/were + going to) He asked if I was going to travel that summer.
Can Can you speak English? →	Could He asked if I could speak English.
May May I go out →	Might He asked me if he might go out.
