D: No, she ¹⁴ mustn't smoke in the shop so she ¹⁵ has to smoke on the street.

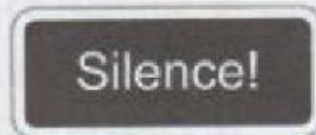
