- The boy is playing the guitar.
- The girl is drinking coffee.

He/She/It (Pronouns)  
He → boy (male)  
She → girl (female)  
e.g. He is playing the guitar.  
e.g. She is drinking coffee.  
It → objects/animals  
e.g. The dog is barking.  
It is barking.
