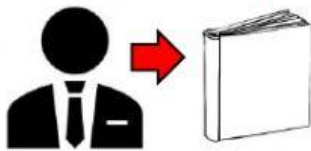


Demonstrative Pronouns– Level A1

This is an apple.

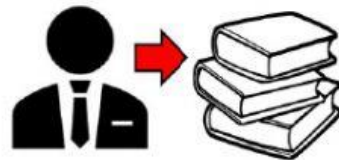
This is an eggplant.

Examples:

These are apples.

These are eggplants.

These are cherries.
