3. My uncle went on a fishing trip and caught 537 lobster tails. He sold 500 of them. How many lobster tails are left?
4. The school library has 114 books. They order 224 more books. How many books will they have in all?
5. The ice-cream shop has 124 flavors of ice-cream. They sell 104 flavors of ice-cream. How many ice-cream flavors are left?
6. My friend made 553 donuts. She, also, made 132 tarts. How many donuts and tarts did she bake altogether?
