



Bimini: Legends and Game Fishing

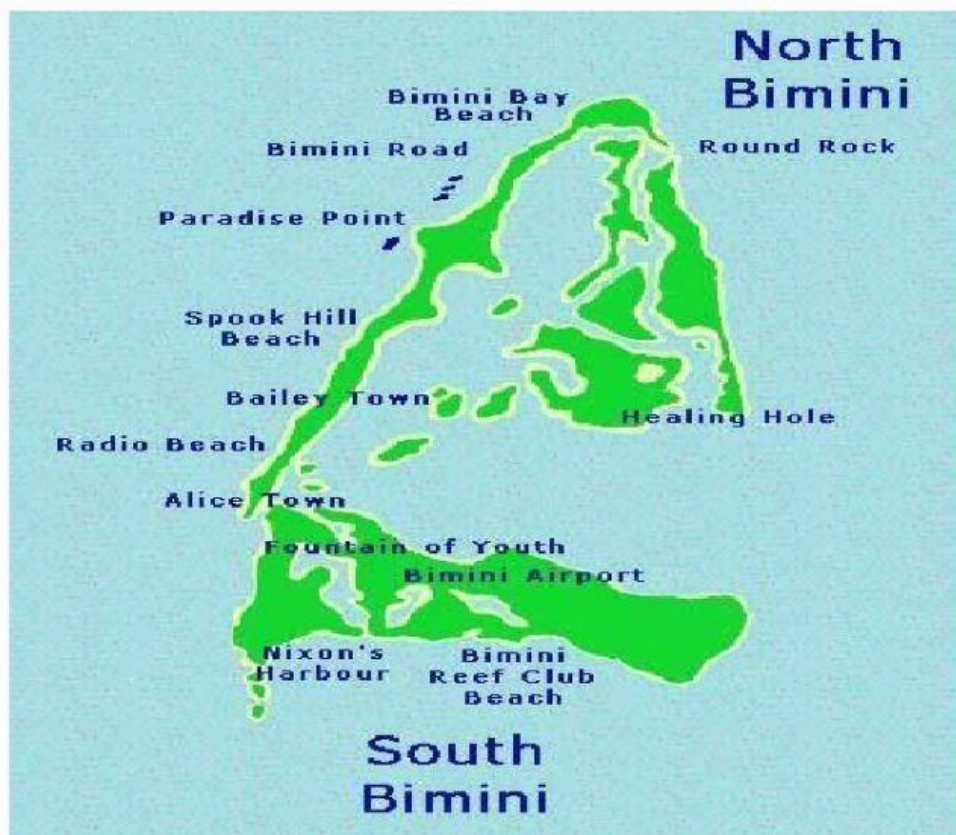
Bimini is about 50 miles east of Miami, Florida. It is the closest Bahama island to the United States. About 2000 people live in Bimini. Bimini is made up of two islands **North Bimini** and **South Bimini**. The capital of Bimini is **Alice Town**, which is found on North Bimini.

The island of Bimini is famous for **deep sea fishing**. Fish such as **tuna**, **grouper**, **snapper**, **wahoo**, and **blue marlin** are caught. They sometimes have tournaments and prizes are given for catching the largest fish.

Bimini has many legendary places like, **The Fountain of Youth**, which **Ponce de León** searched for, the **Healing Hole** and the **Lost City of Atlantis**. Bimini is very small, so a person can get to many of the attractions by foot.
