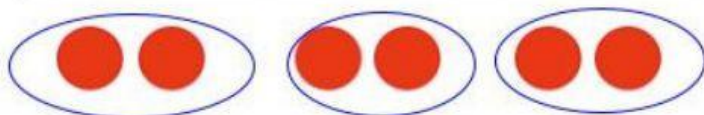
Finding Fractional Parts of a Set

You can use counters to help you find fractional parts of a set.

Learning Practice

Kate made 6 cupcakes. If she eats $\frac{1}{3}$ of them, how many cupcakes did she eat?

Model the cupcakes with counters. Put 6 counters into 3 equal groups.



There are 2 counters in each group.

$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 6 = 2$$

Kate ate 2 cupcakes.

More Practice:

A. Find $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6.

Put 6 counters into 2 equal groups.

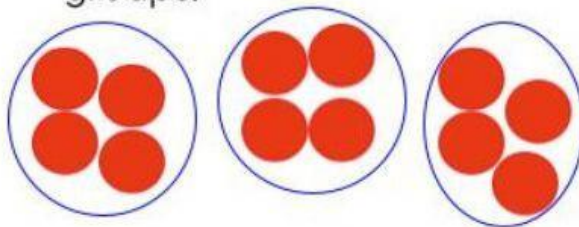


How many in each group?

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 6 = \boxed{}$$

B. Find $\frac{1}{3}$ of 12.

Put 12 counters into 3 equal groups.



How many in each group?

$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 12 = \boxed{}$$
