\*Bear has two past participles **born** and **borne** with difference in meaning.

We use **born** to talk about birth and **borne** for any other thing **not related** to birth.

\*Hang has two past participle forms **hung** and **hanged** that are also its simple past with a change in meaning.

**Hung** is used when **we are not** talking about someone sentenced by law to die by hanging.

**Hanged** is used when we are talking about someone who is put to death by hanging.

\*Lie is easily confused, since it's also the simple past tense of Lie (Irregular). Its past participle is the same as its past tense.

\*Lie is another confusing verb. Lie can be irregular or regular with a difference in meaning. In this activity we are focusing on its irregular form.

**Lie (Irregular)** refers to the horizontal position to sleep whether on a bed or on the floor.

**Lie (Regular)** means not to tell truth.
