<p>☺ Some is used with both <u>countable</u> (plural noun พหูพจน์) and <u>uncountable nouns</u>:</p> <p>Countable Nouns - 'Some <u>students</u> in my school like doing sport.'</p> <p>Uncountable Nouns - 'There is some <u>dust</u> (ฝุ่น) on the table'</p> <p>☺ Some is used in <u>positive sentences</u> (ประโยคบอกเล่า): 'I have some <u>friends</u>.' 'There is some <u>coffee</u>.'</p>	<p>☺ Any is used in <u>negative sentences</u>: 'I don't have any <u>friends</u>.' (countable noun) 'There isn't any <u>coffee</u>.' (uncountable noun)</p> <p>☺ Any is used in <u>questions</u>: 'Do you have any <u>money</u>?' 'Is there any <u>sugar</u>?'</p> <p>☺ Any is used with both <u>countable</u> (plural noun พหูพจน์) and <u>uncountable nouns</u></p>
