

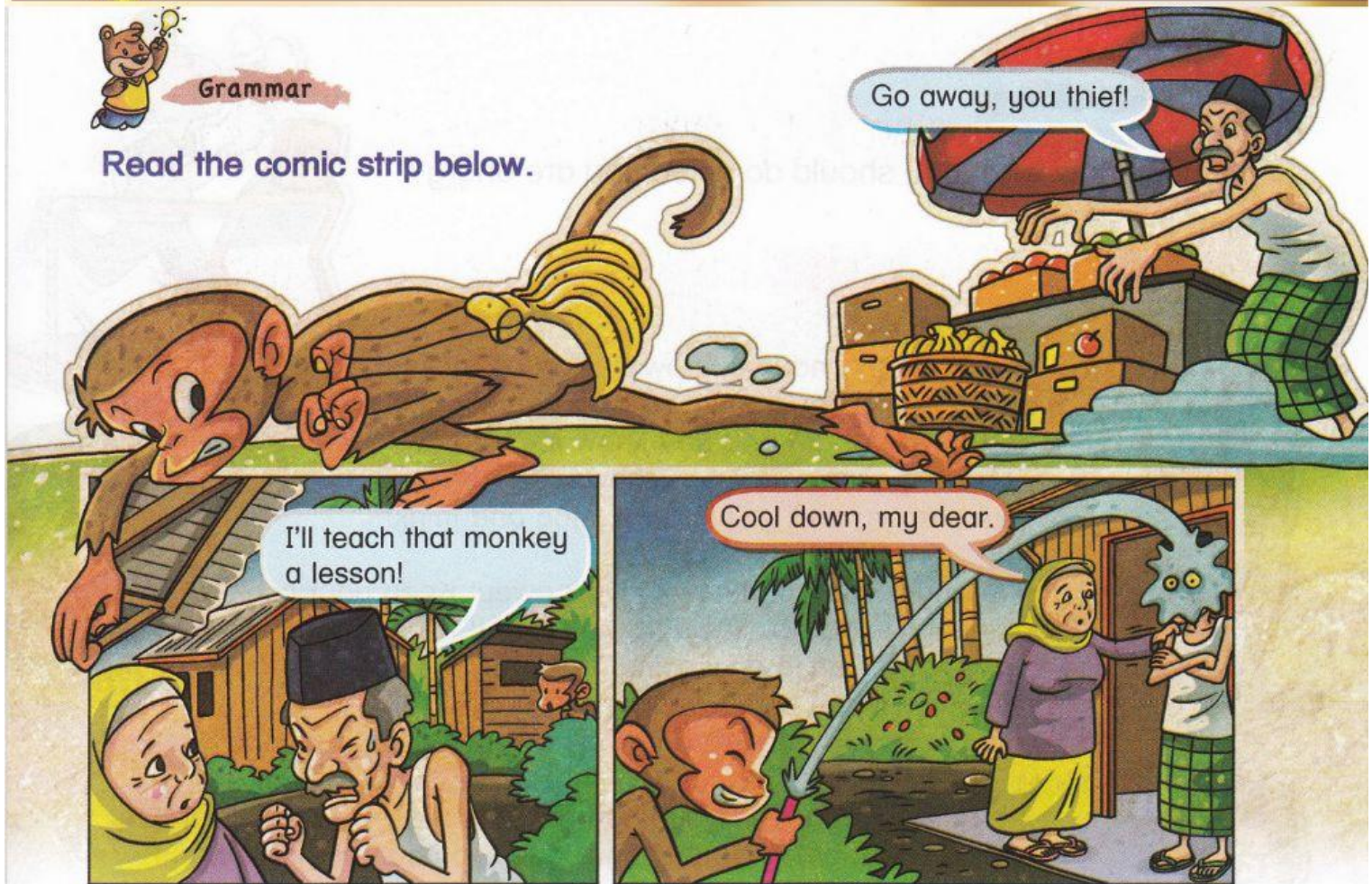


Exclamatory Sentence
