When they go upstairs to the bedroom, Papa bear can see a little girl. She is sleeping on one of the beds!

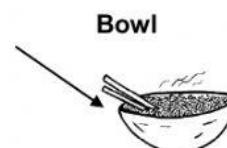
At that moment, Goldilocks wakes up and sees the three bears. She jumps and runs out of the house. She never returns to the home of the three bears.
