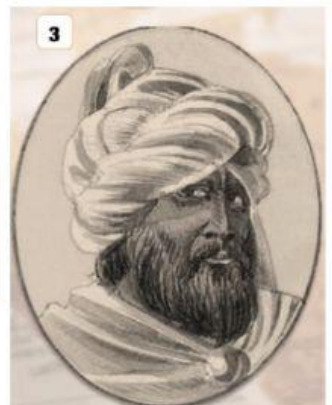
Roald Amundsen (1872 - 1928)

Ibn Battuta (1304 - 1369)

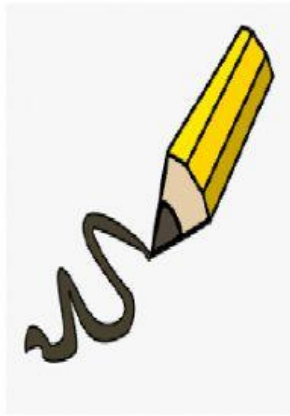
