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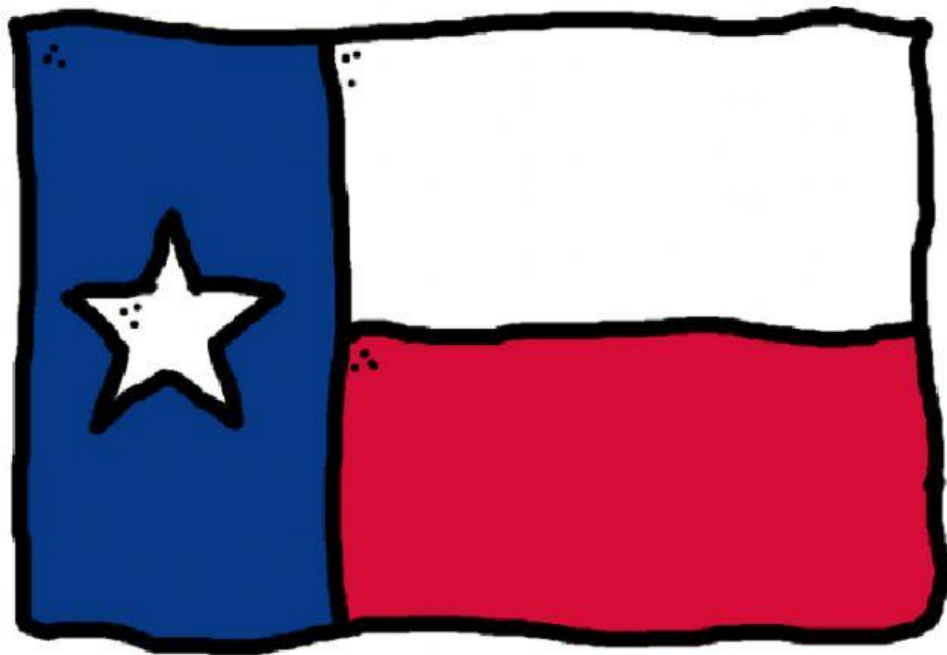

Red means **bravery**

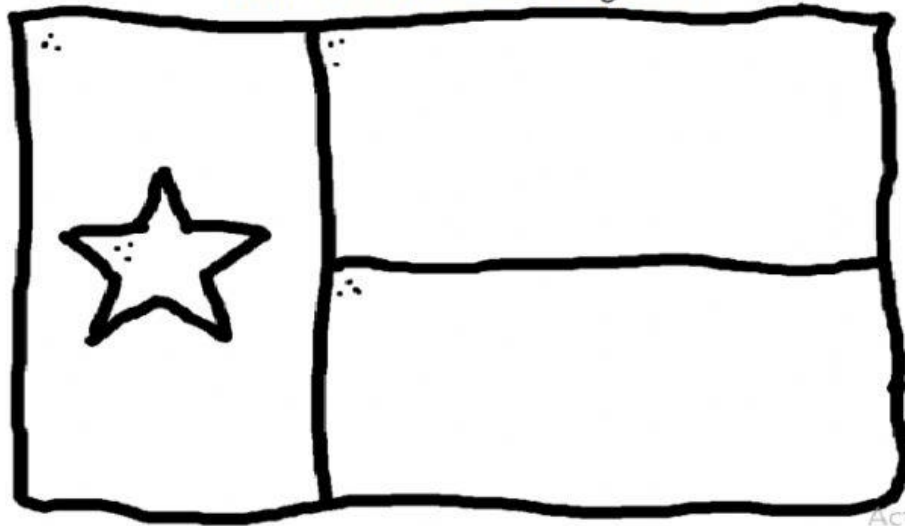

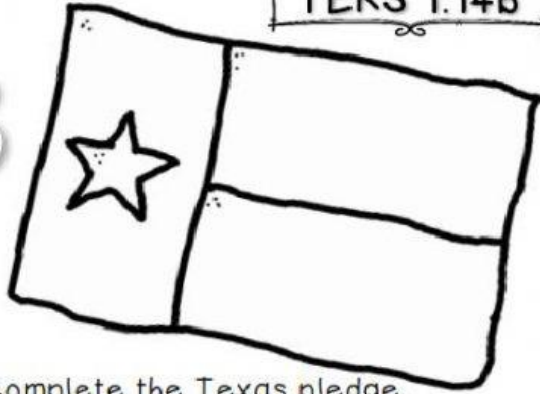

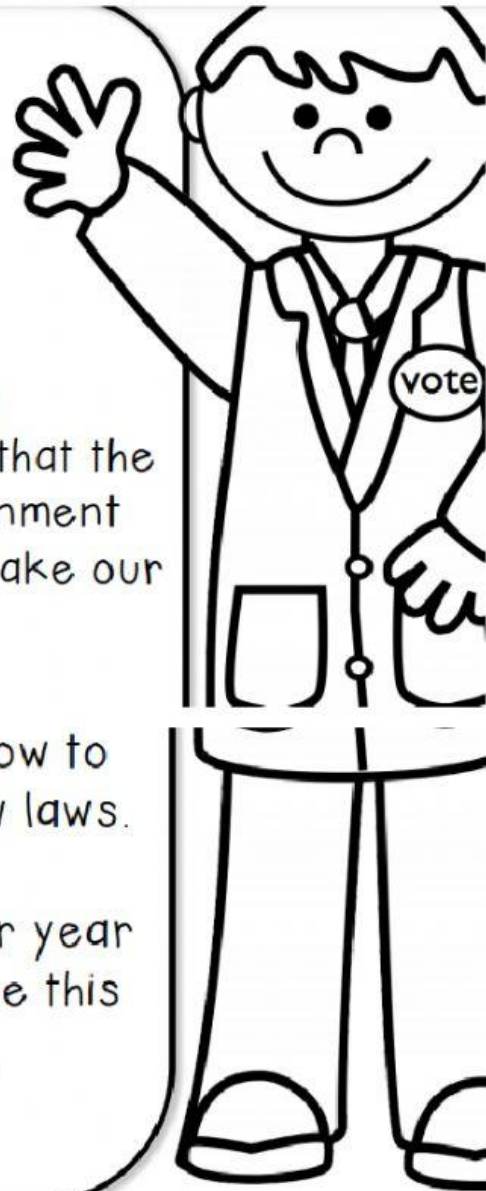
What is a **Governor**?

The governor is a public official. That means that he or she is a leader for our state.

The governor serves a four year term, meaning that they have this job for four years in a row.

- Born in Virginia on March 2, 1793
- Served in the United States Army
- Worked as a lawyer in Tennessee

Role in the History of Texas:

- Helped Texas win their independence from Mexico
- First President of the Republic of Texas
- Served as President of the Republic of Texas two different times (1st and 3rd)
- Served as the 7th Governor of Texas once Texas joined the United States

Other Facts:

- The city of Houston is named after him.
- Sam Houston State University is named after him.
- He also served as the Governor of Tennessee
