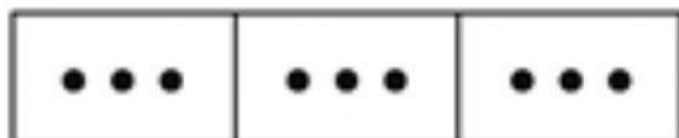


I can recognise fractions of a set of objects.
