Writing planning

PARAGRAPH 1: The introduction is the opening paragraph, and it serves to attract the reader's attention, provide background information on the topic.

PARAGRAPH 2: Mention your hometown and describe your childhood. Talk about your family.

PARAGRAPH 3: Talk about your teenage years, friends, likes, hobbies, activities, studies, etc.

PARAGRAPH 4: Give information about your adult life, jobs, careers, travels, immediate family.

CONCLUSION: Give details describing how your life has been so far.
