Vocabulary:

bit = kousl, minulý čas od *bite* (kousat)

peck = jednotka objemu, do ČJ přesně nepřeložíme

peppers = papriky

picked = vyzvedl, minulý čas od *pick*

pickled = nakládáný

scream = křičet
