

Symbiosis Relationships

Connect the type of relationship to its description.

Amensalism	predator/prey relationship where one organism feeds on another
Commensalism	relationship in which one organism feeds on plants.
Competition	relationship where one organism benefits lives on or in another organism and takes nourishment from that organism. It can weaken the host organism, but usually doesn't kill it.
Herbivory	a relationship where both organisms are benefited.
Mutualism	interaction between organisms in which neither organism is benefited
Parasitism	relationship between organisms in which both the organisms or species are harmed, due to limited resources.
Predation	relationship where one organism benefits and the other is neither harmed nor benefited.
