Many people think that students have a very easy life. We ask Helen and Rupert about their typical day.

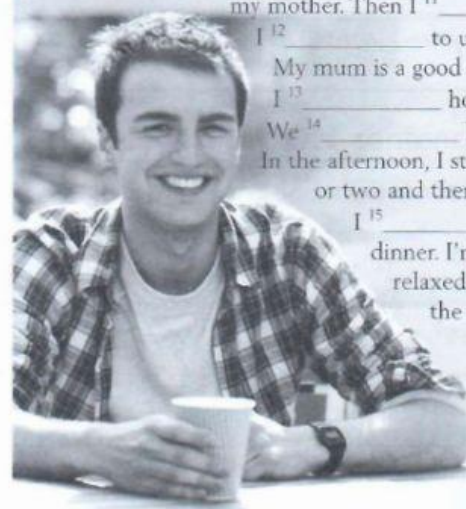

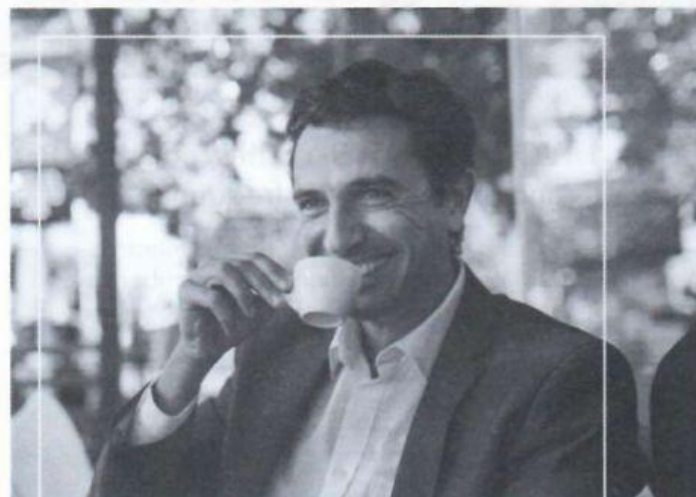
