

Pre-Waqaf Rules

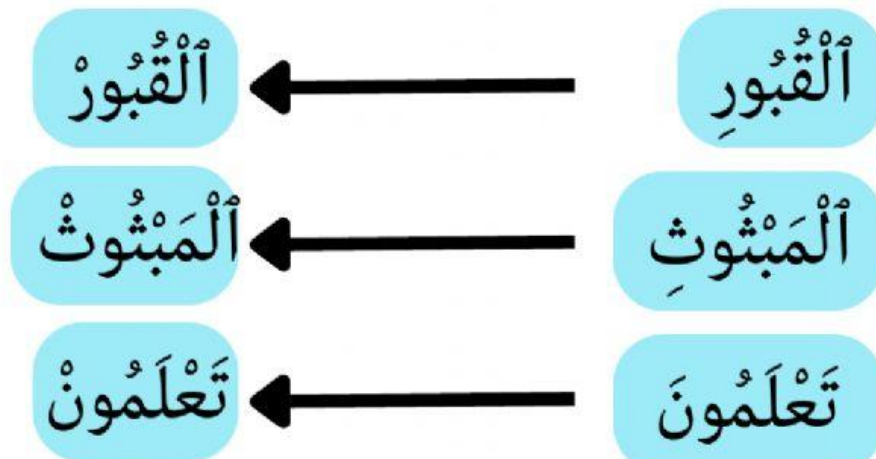
Find the last letter of each word and then place it in the correct harakat group.

Fatha	Dhamma/Dhammatayn	Kasra/Kasratayn

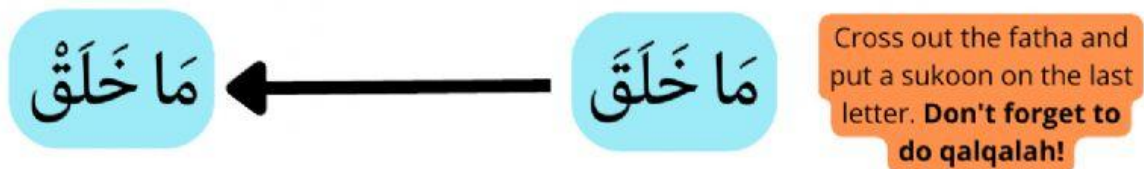

Waqaf Rule 1

When you stop at the end of a word and the last letter has a fatha/ kasra/ kasratayn/ dhamma/ dhammatayn, you must cross the harakat out and replace it with a sukoon.



When you stop at the end of a word and the last letter is one of the qalqalah letter. You must remember to bounce on the letter when waqaf.



Waqaf Rule: How do you stop on the last letter of each word? Write down either "**with sukoon**" or "**with sukoon and qalqalah**."
