The great horned owl has no horns! It is (0) named for the feathers that sit on top of its head.

The great horned owl is (6.1) _____ of the most common owls in North America, found in forests, swamps, deserts, tundra edges, tropical rain forests, cities, suburbs and parks. If you live in North America, (6.2) _____ a good chance you've heard the deep, soft, voice of this owl. The owls use it to advertise their territory. They can also (6.3) _____ a variety of other sounds, including whistles, barks, shrieks and cries. You are most likely to (6.4) _____ an owl at night because they are night birds. They have big eyes and short but wide wings (6.5) _____ allow them to fly through the forest, and their soft feathers help (6.6) _____ approach the victim quietly.

Great horned owls eat a wide variety of food. Geese, small rabbits, birds, and fish make up the main (6.7) _____ of the owls' diet.

They are also great (6.8) _____. They defend their nest at all costs.

Baby owls are ready to fly at between 10 and 12 weeks old.
