He is her brother. → He is not her brother. → He isn't her brother.</p>	<p>Oraciones con auxiliar → se añade not detrás del auxiliar (se suele contraer como n't en inglés oral).</p>	<p>Verbos auxiliares: am, is, are, was, were, have, has, had, will, would, can, could, must, should, may, might,...</p>
<p>2. They speak French. → They do not speak French. → They don't speak French.</p> <p>3. She drives a red car. → She does not drive a red car. → She doesn't drive a red car.</p> <p>4. He ate the sandwich. → He did not eat the sandwich. → He didn't eat the sandwich.</p>	<p>Oraciones sin auxiliar → se usa como auxiliar DO, DOES o DID. El verbo va en infinitivo (sin -s y sin -ed). Se añade NOT detrás del auxiliar, que va detrás del sujeto y delante del verbo.</p>	<p>Se usa DON'T y DOESN'T para el presente simple (DOESN'T si el verbo termina en -s). Se usa DIDN'T para el pasado simple.</p>
