Write the correct preposition.

- The preposition **at** is used to refer to specific times and moments of the day:
ten o'clock
midnight
- We also use **at** with some expressions of time:
Christmas
the present
the moment
the weekend
- The preposition **on** is used with days of the week and dates:
Monday
my birthday
April 10
- The preposition **in** is used with months:
January
the previous month



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- is also used with the seasons of the year:
summer
winter
autumn
spring
- As well as with longer periods of time:
this century
the 1960s
- And with some time expressions that refer to periods of the day (except with "night")
the morning
the afternoon
the evening



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
