| 16 | sew up | | reduce weight |
| 17 | shut down | | remove clothing |
| 18 | sit down | | remove, e.g., bandage |
| 19 | slim down | | run in different directions |
| 20 | stress out | | stop functioning |
| 21 | strip off | | stop functioning |
| 22 | take off | | support / help sby to sit up |
| 23 | throw up | | suture, e.g., a wound |
| 24 | turn round | | vomit |
