

## Famous British dishes- part 2

dish	Name and Ingredients
	<p>It is called <b>Sunday roast with Yorkshire pudding</b>. It is composed of roasted meat (chicken , beef, pork or lamb), vegetables, roast potatoes, Yorkshire puddings and plenty of gravy.</p>
	<p>The <b>Cornish pasty</b> is filled with sliced or diced potato, swede, onion and diced or minced beef in pastry which has a "D" shape.</p>
	<p>The <b>toad in the hole</b> is a dish with sausages sticking out of Yorkshire pudding batter, usually served with vegetables and onion gravy.</p>
	<p>It is called <b>Bubble and squeak</b>. It consists of frying leftover vegetables ( carrots, broccoli, swede with mashed or fried potato) and served with cold leftover meat.</p>
