

ChatGPT is a natural language processing tool driven by AI technology (1) _____ allows you to have human-like conversations and much more with a chatbot. The language model can answer questions, and assist you with tasks such as composing emails, essays, and code.

Usage is currently open to public free of charge because ChatGPT is in its research and feedback-collection phase. As of Feb. 1, there is also a paid subscription version called ChatGPT Plus.

ChatGPT was created by OpenAI, an AI and research company. The company (2) _____ ChatGPT on Nov. 30, 2022.

OpenAI is also responsible for creating DALLÉ•2, a popular AI art generator, and Whisper, an automatic speech (3) _____ system.

It's certainly made a big splash. "ChatGPT is scary good. We are not far from dangerously strong AI," said Elon Musk, who was one of the founders of OpenAI before leaving. Sam Altman, OpenAI's chief, said on Twitter that ChatGPT had more than 1 million users in its first five days after launching. Altman told Musk the average cost of (4) _____ response was in "single-digits cents" but admitted it will need to monetize it eventually because of its "eye-watering" compute costs.

(5) _____ analysis by Swiss bank UBS, ChatGPT is the fastest growing app of all time. In January, only two months after its launch, UBS analysis estimates that ChatGPT had 100 million active users. For comparison, it took nine months for TikTok to reach 100 million.
