His neighbour .....Nasreddin one pot but Nasreddin gave back

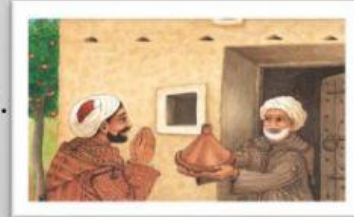
two pots. Nasreddin ..... "Your pot had a baby at my house".
