- \_\_\_\_\_ Jem has an outburst after enduring Mrs Dubouse's remarks and Atticus teach the kids a lesson.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Calpurnia takes the kids to church and they have the chance to experience a different world.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Aunt Alexandra comes to Maycomb and tries to instill traditional values in the kids and lady manners in Scout.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tom Robinson's trial begins.
