FOR/SINCE-PRESENT PERFECT

FOR: We use "for" with a period of time e.g. 3 hours, 2 years, ages, a long time, months, years. "For" means from the beginning of the period to the end of the period.

- + Mick and I have been friends for 20 years.
- + She hasn't been to the cinema for ages.
- + We have been married for about a year.

SINCE: We use "since" with a point in time e.g. 1 o'clock, last Monday, 1995, I finished high school, the beginning of this semester. "Since" means from that point in time until now.

- + Bob and I have been friends since last May.
- + She hasn't fed her cat since this morning.
- + My parents have been married since 1990.
