4. 'The Industrial Revolution was a period of major economic and social change that occurred during the 18th and 19th centuries in Europe and North America. It marked a shift from manual labor to machine-based manufacturing and led to advances in transportation, communication, and industry. The Industrial Revolution began in Britain in the late 1700s and spread to other parts of Europe and the United States over the next century.' _____

5. Arthur Conan Doyle (1859-1930) was a British author and physician, best known for his creation of the fictional detective Sherlock Holmes. Born in Scotland, Conan Doyle studied medicine at the University of Edinburgh before moving to London to set up his medical practice. However, his true passion lay in writing and he published his first Sherlock Holmes story, "A Study in Scarlet," in 1887. _____
