CAN VS COULD

CAN

ABILITY (present)

- I **can** speak Chinese.

POSSIBILITY (present)

- One wrong move **can** lose the whole game.

COULD

ABILITY (past)

- He **could** swim well when he was ten years old.

POSSIBILITY (past)

- A lot of employees **could** be fired.
