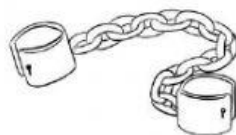

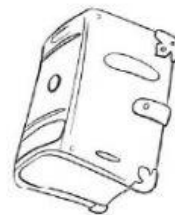

We use the **verb to be** to make sentences in the present time. It changes with the different pronouns:

I → am	YOU → are	HE → is
	WE → are	SHE → is
	THEY → are	IT → is

When we use them in the negative form we add **NOT** at the end of each verb:

I → am not = I'm not	YOU → are not = aren't	HE → is not = isn't
	WE → are not = aren't	SHE → is not = isn't
	THEY → are not = aren't	IT → is not = isn't
