

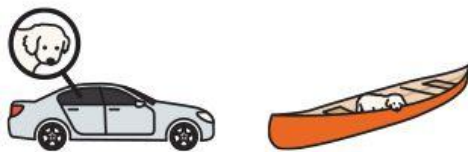

In

Where's the puppy? Use **in** when the puppy is **inside** a small mode of transportation (even if it isn't completely enclosed).

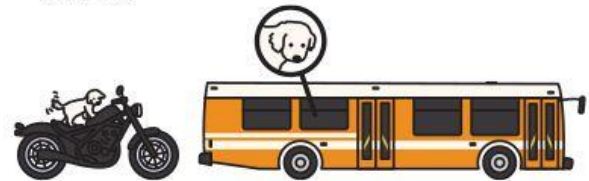
- in a car
- in a canoe



On

Where's the puppy? Use **on** when the puppy is **on top of** a small mode of transportation or **inside** a large one.

- on a motorcycle
- on a bus



Note:

For some modes of transportation, **in** and **on** are both possible.

- in / on a helicopter
- in / on a submarine
