Richard Burton Richard Burton was a famous Hollywood actor in the 50s and 60s. He was known for his great voice and handsome looks. Richard Burton was born in Wales in the United Kingdom in 1925. He came from a poor family. Burton never studied at a theater school, but he eventually went to Oxford University. Later he started his professional career as an actor, and he worked in some of England's most famous theaters. Burton's first movie was "My Cousin Rachel" (1952). Critics really liked the movie, and this was the start of his film career. He never received an Academy Award, but he was nominated for Best Actor six times. His other famous movies were "Hamlet" (1960) and "The Spy Who Came in from the Cold" (1966). People were very interested in Burton's lifestyle and relationships. He was married four times. He married actress Elizabeth Taylor twice. Taylor and Burton met while filming "Cleopatra" (1964). They were both married when they started their world-famous love affair. There were many stories of the fights between Burton and Taylor. The couple married for a second time in 1975 but got divorced in 1976. Richard Burton's last movie was "1984" (1984). This was the year that he died at the age of 58 in his home in Switzerland.
