Vocabulary :

- fear (n.):** the feeling you get when you are afraid or worried that something bad is going to happen (ความกลัว)
- sleepy (adj.):** ready to go to sleep (ง่วงนอน)
- tired (adj.):** needing rest (เหนื่อย, อ่อนล้า)
- bored (adj.):** feeling tired and impatient (เบื่อหน่าย)
- laugh (v.):** to make the sounds and movements of your face that show you are happy or thinks something is funny (หัวเราะ)
- funny (adj.):** making you laugh, amusing (น่าขบขัน, ตลก)
- angry (adj.):** having strong feeling about something that you dislike very much (โกรธ, โมโห)
- couple (n.):** two people who are married or having romantic relationship (คู่สามีภรรยา)
- sad (adj.):** unhappy or showing unhappiness (เศร้า, ไม่มีความสุข)
- happy (adj.):** feeling or showing pleasure (มีความสุข, อารมณ์ดี)
- frightened (adj.):** afraid, feeling fear (ตกใจ, กลัว)
- nervous (adj.):** anxious about something or afraid of something (กระวนกระวาย, เป็นประสาท)
- lonely (adj.):** unhappy because you have no friend or people to talk to (เหงา, โดดเดี่ยว)
- afraid of (adj.):** feeling fear of frightened (กลัว)
- cry (v.):** to produce tears from your eyes because you are unhappy or hurt (ร้องไห้)
- mad (adj.):** angry, crazy, or very silly (บ้าคลั่ง, ไร้สติ)
- disappointed (adj.):** unhappy because something you hoped for did not happen (ผิดหวัง)
- surprised (adj.):** feeling or showing surprise (ประหลาดใจ)

Negative Questions with Why

คือ คำถามในรูปปฏิเสธ ที่ขึ้นต้นด้วย **Why** เพื่อใช้ในการเสนอแนะให้ทำบางสิ่งบางอย่าง เช่น

*Why don't you go and get it? ทำไมคุณไม่ไปเอล่ะ

*Why don't you have some medicine? ทำไมคุณไม่กินยาล่ะ

*Why doesn't he take a rest? ทำไมเขาไม่พักผ่อนล่ะ

โครงสร้างของคำถาม

Why + don't + you, we, they + Verb?

doesn't + he, she + Verb?

*** Why don't / doesn't? มีความหมายว่า ทำไมไม่.....

Why / Because

Why เป็นคำถามที่ถามหาคำตอบที่ต้องการคำอธิบายเหตุผล ว่าทำไม เพราะอะไร เพราะเหตุใด

Because การตอบจึงควรมีเหตุผลแจกแจงหรือมีเพราะว่าประกอบด้วย เช่น

A: Why are you smiling?

Q: Why is he quiet?

B: Because I'm happy.

A: Because he's so sad.
