

Simple future Will and Won't



We use it when we need to say what will happen, or with promises, refuses, offers.

POSITIVE FORM

SUBJECT + WILL + BASE FORM

EXAMPLE:

WHEN FINISH THE CLASS, I
WILL EAT A COOKIE.

THEY WILL PICK UP THE KEYS.

QUESTIONS

WH + WILL /WILL NOT +
SUBJECT+ BASE FORM

EXAMPLE:

WHEN WILL THE TEACHER
ARRIVE?

WILL YOU STAY AT
GRANDMA'S HOME TONIGHT?

NEGATIVE FORM

SUBJECT + WILL NOT + BASE
FORM

EXAMPLE

I DON'T LIKE THEM SO I WILL
NOT GO TO THE PARTY.

HE WILL NOT HELP YOU.
