

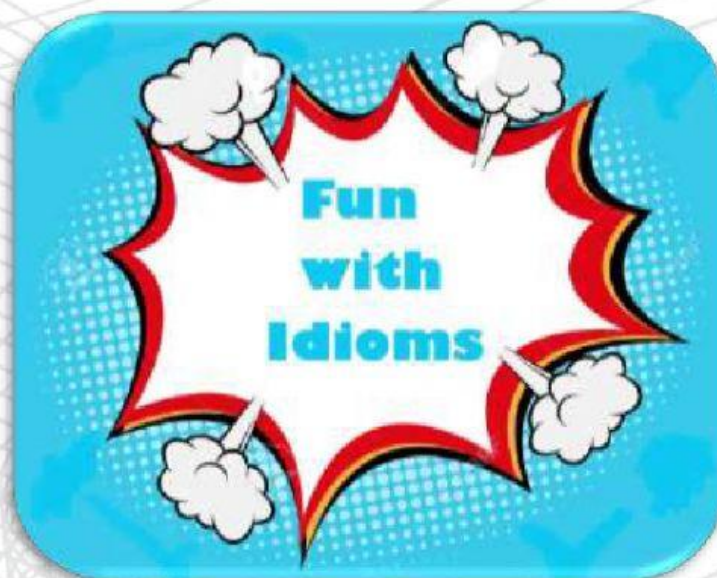


Module 1 – Idioms
