PAST SIMPLE TENSE

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Affirmative

SUBJECT + VERB

I / you / we / they + lived

he / she / it + lived

There is only one form of each verb in the past simple tense.
The exception is TO BE which has two forms: was and were.

Play / I lived in a small apartment.
He lived in a big house.
They played football yesterday.

To make a past tense verb, we normally just add -ED to the end of a regular verb.
