


What makes up our **HOUSE**

- Walls, _____ and doors, floor and roof are important **components** of a house.
- It's an extra space on the second floor, privately for family members, next to the bedroom.
- They welcome **guests** and allow **entrance** and **exit** of the house.
- It's a top **structure** covering a house, providing **protection** against wind, rain, snow and sunlight.
- It's a room furnished with a bed for sleeping.
- They are opening in the wall of a house for **visibility**, air and light.
- It's a room where food is prepared or cooked.
- It's the **bottom** surface of a room, may be stone, wood, metal, etc.
- There are many _____ rooms in a house, bedroom, bathroom, kitchen, dining room and a living room.
- It's a room containing a toilet, sink, bathtub and shower.
- It's a room in a house where family gather for **entertainment** and welcoming guests.
- The windows let the light and air into the house. They allow us to see the outside view. Also, they keep us safe and _____ from the wind and rain.
- It's a room **below** the **ground** floor in a house that is often used as a utility space for heating system and storage of wines.
- They **support** the roof and are constructed from bricks, woods, plasterboards, clay, cement, etc. for the purpose of **privacy**, **security** and room **separation**.
- It's an additional room or space below the roof of the house.
- It's a space with a floor and **railings** on the outside of a house that project from the walls so you can enjoy the view from up top.



- It's a room, built next to or as part of a house, where cars are kept.
- A **duplex** is a two _____ house with **staircase** connecting the two **floors** inside the house.
- It's a room in a house which **meals** are eaten.
