When they got back, it was nearly dark.

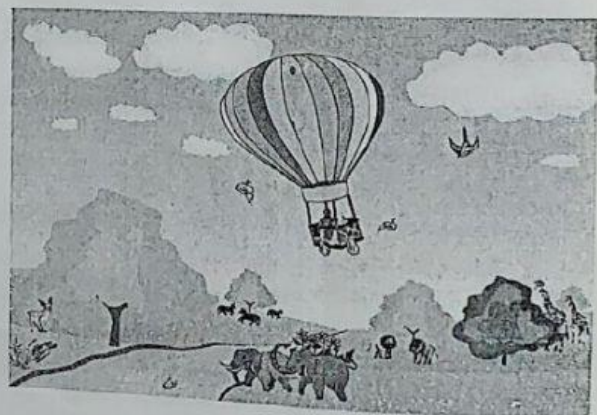
"Today was super fun!" Tania said. "I don't know what could be better than that."

(+) S + V2/ED + O.

(-) S + DIDN'T + Vbare + O.

(?) DID + S + Vbare + O?

Signal words: yesterday, ago, last night,
Last week, last month, last year, in 1990, v.v...

PRESENT PERFECT (HIỆN TẠI HOÀN THÀNH)

(+) S + HAVE/HAS + V3/ED + O.

(-) S + HAVEN'T/ HASN'T + V3/ED + O.

(?) HAVE/HAS + S + V3/ED + O?

Signal words: since, for, ever, never, just, yet,
So far, up to now, recently, once, twice,
before, v.v...
