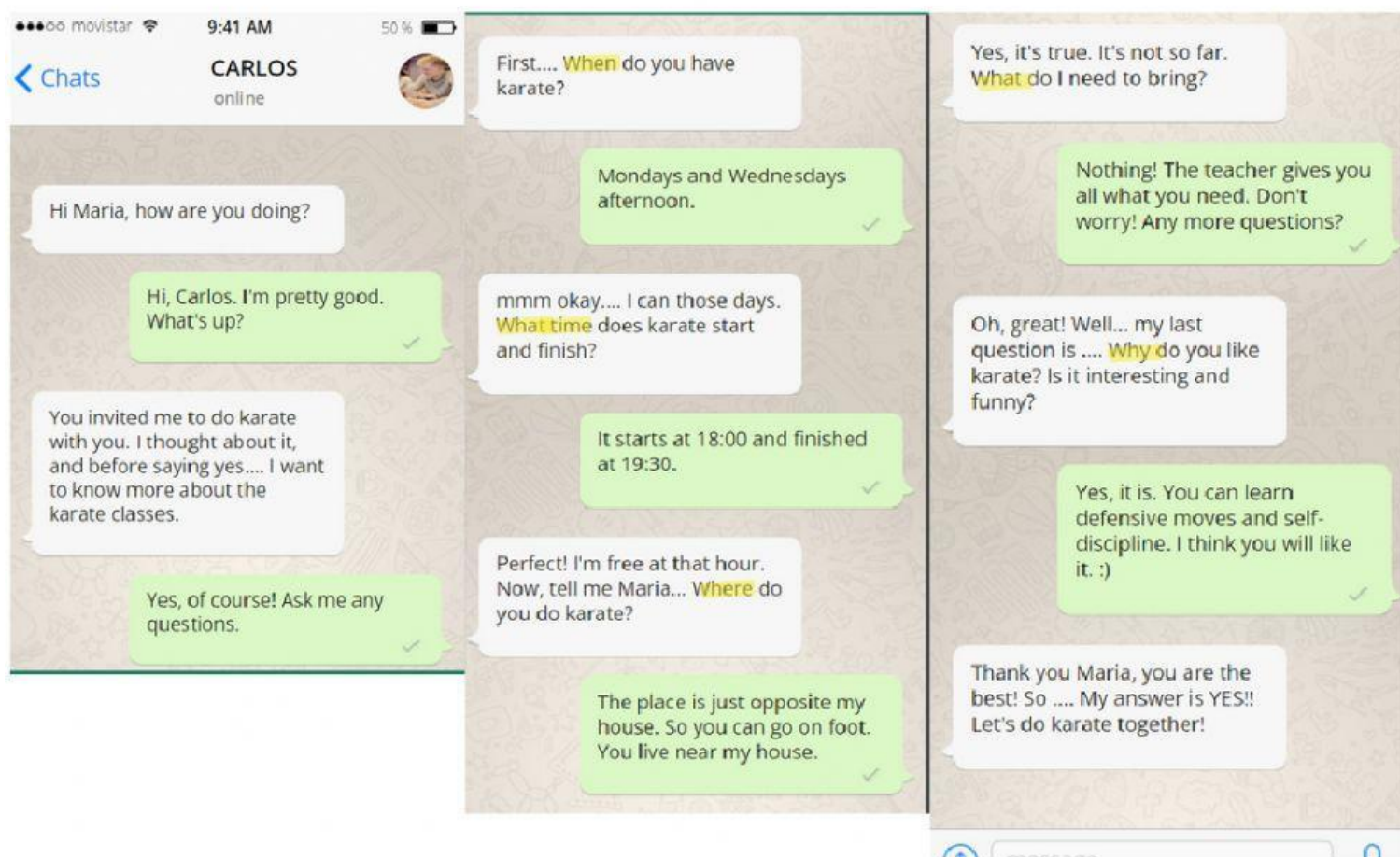


READING
