



Common Idiom: FEELINGS

No.	IDIOM	EXAMPLE	EXPLANATION
1	on cloud nine	After receiving the job offer, she was on cloud nine.	<i>a strong belief about someone or something that cannot completely be explained and does not have to be decided by reasoning</i> a <i>linh cảm</i>
2	down in the dumps	Ever since she failed her exam, she's been down in the dumps.	<i>to annoy someone a lot</i> b <i>làm ai đó cáu bẳn</i>
3	feeling blue	I've been feeling blue since I broke up with my partner.	<i>to be extremely happy or elated.</i> c <i>'bay trên chín tầng mây'</i>
4	make someone's blood boil	His disrespectful comments made her blood boil.	<i>to feel sad or melancholic.</i> d <i>cảm thấy buồn</i>
5	lose someone's head	In a moment of anger, he lost his head and said something he regretted.	<i>to feel sorry or sad about something that has already happened; used to emphasize that this is not helpful</i> e <i>khóc vì sửa bị đổ; tiếc cái đã qua</i>
6	under the weather	I can't come to work today as I'm feeling under the weather.	<i>to feel unwell or sick</i> f <i>không khỏe</i>
7	cry over spilt milk	Don't cry over spilt milk, focus on finding a solution.	<i>to feel very sad or depressed.</i> g <i>buồn bã; suy sụp tinh thần</i>
8	gut feeling	Even without concrete evidence, I have a gut feeling that something is wrong.	<i>to increase someone's interest in and wish for something, usually by giving them a small experience of it</i> h <i>kích thích 'khẩu vị'</i>
9	get on someone's nerves	His constant procrastination really gets on my nerves.	<i>to lose control and not act in a calm way</i> i <i>mất bình tĩnh; mất kiểm soát</i>
10	whet one's appetite	I've read an excerpt of the book on the Web and it's whetted my appetite.	<i>to make someone extremely angry or enraged.</i> j <i>làm ai đó phẫn nộ; làm sôi máu</i>
