Limited range of communication than auditory or visual cues.

Specific form of communication, which reduces a predator's ability to detect them.

A large amount of energy is needed to move long distances, and there is the possibility of increased predation while moving.

Increase their chance of survival by moving to a location that has better climate conditions and more food.

Increases an offspring's chance of survival. Genes of the parents continue to be present in future generations.

Parents spend increased amounts of energy on caring for offspring, possibly at the cost of the parents' health or safety.
