1. He is her brother. V ^ Is he her brother?	Oraciones con auxiliar → se invierte el orden del sujeto y el verbo.	Verbos auxiliares: am, is, are, was, were, have, has, had, will, would, can, could, must, should, may, might,...
2. They speak French. Do they speak French?	Oraciones sin auxiliar → se usa como auxiliar DO, DOES o DID. El verbo va en infinitivo (sin -s y sin -ed).	Se usa DO y DOES para el presente simple (DOES si el verbo termina en -s). Se usa DID para el pasado simple.
3. She drives a red car. Does she drive a red car?		
4. He finished the exam early. Did he finish the exam early?
