>> Dù giàu tới cỡ nào, hũ chưa bao giờ giúp đỡ người nghèo.

→ He prides himself

* *Gợi ý: + pride (v) tự hào. Cách dùng: Somebody **prides** himself / herself on sth/doing sth
+ proud (adj) tự hào. Cách dùng: Somebody **is proud of** sth/doing sth*
Hắn tự hào mình là thủ quân của đội tuyển bóng đá quốc gia.

5. I don't care at all whether you stay or go.

→ It doesn't matter

* *Gợi ý: do not care at all: không quan tâm.*
I don't care at all = It doesn't matter to me
Tao cóc cần quan tâm mày ở hay đi.
