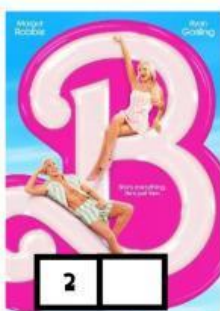

subject verb phrase object

Active

Emphasis on the doer or performer

The dog chased the cat.

Passive

Emphasis on the result or receiver

The cat was chased by the dog.
