Raindrops	(n) A single drop of rain / σταγόνες βροχής
Whiskers	(n) (of an animal) long stiff hairs that grow near its mouth / μουστάκια (γάτας κλπ)
Kittens	(n) A very young cat / γατάκι
Bright	(adj) Not dark, strong and noticeable (colour) / φωτεινό, ανοιχτό
Copper	(n) Soft reddish-brown metal / χαλκός
Kettles	(n) A covered container that you use for boiling water / χύτρα, κασαρόλα
Weave (-wove- woven)	(v) Knit / πλεκώ
Mittens	(n) Kind of glove covering four fingers together and the thumb separately / γαντάκια (χωρίς δάκτυλα)
Package	(n) A small parcel / πακέτο
Tie up	(v) Fasten together with a string/rope / δένω
String	(n) A thin rope made of twisted threads / σπάγγος / κορδόνι
Favourite	(adj) The one that you like most / αγαπημένος, αυτός που προτιμώ περισσότερο απ' όλους
Coloured	(adj) Having a particular colour or combination of colours / χρωματιστός
Pony (ies)	(n) A type of small horse / πόνυ
Crisp	(adj) Food, pleasantly hard and crunchy / τραγανός
Strudel (s)	(n) A kind of (Austrian) sweet, kind of tart made of fruit / τάρτα φρούτων
Sleigh	(n) A vehicle which can slide over snow / έλκηθρο
Bell	(n) A device that makes a ringing sound which attracts people's attention / καμπάνα
Schnitzel	(n) Austrian food / σνίτσελ
Noodles	(n) Long, thin pieces of pasta / λαζάνια, κυλοπίτες
Wild	(adj) Uncontrolled, unrestrained, unruly / άγριος, αδάμαστος
Goose (geese)	(n) Large bird similar to duck with a long neck / χήνα
Wing(s)	(n) The wings of a bird are the parts of its body that it uses for flying / φτερά
Satin	(adj) Smooth and shiny type of cloth / σατέν (ύφασμα)
Sash (-es)	(n) Long strip of cloth worn round the waist or over one shoulder for ornament or as part of a uniform / πλατειά ζώνη ή λουρίδα από ύφασμα
Snowflake	(n) Feather-like collection of frozen raindrops / νιφάδα χιονιού
Eyelash (-es)	(n) Your eyelashes are the hairs which grow on the edges of your eyelids / βλεφαρίδες
Melt (-ed)	(v) When a solid substance changes to a liquid because it is being heated / λιώνω
Bite (bit-bitten)	(v) Use the teeth to cut into or cut through sth / δαγκώνω (animals, snakes, mosquitoes and ants bite but wasps and bees sting)
Bee	(n) An insect with yellow-and-black striped body / μέλισσα
Sting (stung-stung)	(v) When an insect or plant stings you, it pricks your skin usually with poison so that you feel a sharp pain / κεντρίζω
