A HAPPY, HEALTHY NEW YEAR

All around the world the New Year is a time of celebration, and any customs on this day include food. This is because people believe some foods can bring health and good luck for the next year. For example, on New Year's Day people in the country of Argentina eat beans because they believe beans will help them to find a better job in the New Year.

If you want good luck in the coming year, here are some other foods you should try!

Fruit For Good Luck

In Spain, as the clock turns to midnight, people eat twelve grapes--one at each ring of the clock. Stores sell these small round fruits in packs of twelve because each grape brings good luck for one month of the year. It is not easy to eat twelve grapes this quickly, but if you do it, it will be a lucky year. However, if one of your grapes is too sour, you might have a difficult month!

Pasta For a Long Life

In China, it's usual to eat long noodles, or thin pieces of pasta made with egg, on New Year's day. The Chinese believe the longer the noodle is, the longer your life will be. So when you are cooking the noodles, it's important to use a big enough pot. But, you need to be sure that the noodles aren't too long because it's bad luck to break one before it is all in your mouth!

A Sweet Year Ahead

New Year's cake is another popular custom in many cultures. For instance, at midnight on New Year's Eve in Greece, families eat the Vasilopita. Vasilopita is sweet bread-like cake. It looks like a small round cake on top of a large round cake. The cake is simple, not too rich, nor too sweet. It is special because a member of the family hides a gold coin inside of it. It is usual to serve the cake to the youngest family member first, and then continue to older family members. As soon as everyone has a piece, you can check to see if you have the gold coin. If you find the coin, you will have good luck for the year!

So, when the New Year comes around, remember: if you want to have a happy, healthy year, you have a lot of eating to do!
